 - Define the scope: Introduce attendees to the scope of Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children in the United States. Identify state and local high-risk factors while introducing federal and state laws.
 - Uncover vulnerabilities: Build knowledge of key vulnerabilities of at-risk groups, such as children involved with child welfare and/or juvenile justice, runaways, youth with truancy violations, and homeless children.
 - Recognize the dynamics: Understand the drivers, including buyer demand, pimp manipulation and control, abuse within the home, the intersection with first-responder jobs, and cultural facilitators.
 - Recover victims: Know the red flags to look for in a victim, including physical and psychological signs of involvement, and how to professionally intervene safely, without causing additional trauma or jeopardizing evidence.
 - Grasp complexity of healing: Familiarize participants with the psychological and physical aftermath of trafficking, including trauma bonds, and the strength-based trauma-informed methods and wraparound services essential for holistic healing.
 - Pinpoint needed changes and strategies: Worked with multidisciplinary teams to begin discussions on required changes to current policies and procedures.
